Display Audio system that keeps you connected through hands-free Bluetooth functionality (available with Apple or Andoid phones) as well as a mirror function for viewing navigation and approved apps straight from your compatible Apple iPhone (5 or above).

Standard active safety features in the Honda City include Anti-lock Braking System, Electronic Brakeforce Distribution, Emergency Brake Assist, Emergency Stop Signal, Hill Start Assist, Vehicle Stability Assist with Traction Control System and six airbags.

The multi-view rear camera has three different modes (normal, wide and top-down) and is standard across the range.

Sipping just 5.7 litres per one hundred kilometers for the CVT and 5.8 litres per one hundred kilometers for the five-speed manual, the Honda City delivers outstanding fuel efficiency and is competitively priced from a Manufacturer's List Price of just \$15,990 (VTi manual with flat paint only).
